In India, the copyright act was passed by Government of India in 1957 and the law has been amended for six times. The most recent amendment was made in 2012. National Intellectual Property Right was approved by parliament on 12th May 2016.

Intellectual Property Rights include patents, copy rights, industrial design rights, trademarks, plant variety rights, trade dress and geographical indications. It also includes other types of rights, such as trade secrets, publicity rights, moral rights, etc. Artistic works like music and literature as well as discoveries, inventions, words, phrases, symbols and designs can all be protected as intellectual property.

The main purpose of Intellectual law is to encourage the creation of a large variety of intellectual goods. This law gives the people rights for a limited period of time as they can earn profit from their creation.

Considering the importance of this issue, the seminar is organized. It will include thorough discussion and creation of awareness among the people about Intellectual Property Rights
