Literary and Cultural Association of Dayanand Science College organized UGC-CPE Sponsored Three Days Workshop on 'Fine Arts ' during 13-15, September 2019. The objective of this workshop was to broaden and to enlighten the concept of fine arts among the students. The inauguration of the workshop was held on 13 September 2019 with Saraswatipoojan and lighting the lamp by the auspicious hands of the Chief Guest Shri Shailesh Gojamgunde (Renowned Theater Person). Principal Dr. J.S Dargad presided over the function. Vice Principal Dr. S. S. Bellale and Coordinator of the Workshop Asst. Prof. M. M. Pandit were present on the dais. In the beginning, Coordinator M. M. Pandit delivered the introductory speech in which she stated the objectives behind the organization of the workshop. In his inaugural speech, Shri Shailesh Gojamgunde talked about the importance of art in human life and explained the term 'Fine Arts' in detail. In the presidential address, Principal Dr. J.S Dargad highlighted the value of art in making life meaningful and happy. He emphasized on the need of organizing such workshops for encouraging the creative talent of the students. At last Dr. C. S. Swami proposed vote of thanks.

The inaugural ceremony was followed by Session I on 'Natyavishakar' which was conducted by Shri Shailesh Gojamgunde. In this session Shri Shailesh Gojamgunde introduced various dramatic terms and techniques. Session II was conducted by renowned mimicry artist Shri Balaji Sul. He gave the information about mimicry, mime and skit. With wonderful practical performance, he made the session interesting. In session III, resource person Prof. Dadasaheb Londhe delivered a talk on 'Developing Elocution Skill'. He had given valuable guidelines regarding the preparation of a speech, its content and language, importance of reading habit, updated knowledge and the role of body language while delivering a speech.

After session III, the participants had given the opportunity to watch the drama performance and interviews of great artists on projector. On Day 1, Rangoli Exhibition was organized between 9-11.00am. The resource persons, our college staff and students appreciated the beautiful rangoli exhibition. The judges evaluated the rangoli and the winner participants had given the prizes in Valedictory Function.

On day 2(14 Sept.2019) between 9.00-10.30 am we organized Painting /Drawing /Sketches /Art and Craft Exhibition. It got a tremendous response. The winner participants had given cash prizes in the valedictory function. Session IV was conducted by Dr Sandip Jagdale who has been working as a lecturer in the Department of Music, Dayanand College of Arts, Latur. He had

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given a talk on 'Introduction to Music'. He introduced different types of music with practical examples. He also talked about instrumental music, specially about tabala.

In Session V, Shri Dinesh Lokhande was the resource person who had given the practical lessons of drawing, painting, sketches and collage. He evaluated the exhibition and according to that he gave valuable guidelines to the participants. Session VI was on 'Creative Writing' which was conducted by Dr Satish Yadav (Head, Department of Hindi, Shivaji College, Renapur, Dist. Latur). He gave a detailed guidance on developing the creative writing talent.


The Valedictory Function was taken place on Day 2 at 4.00 pm in the presence of Chief Guest Dr Satish Yadav and Vice Principal Dr S. S. Bellale. On this occasion, the cash prizes were given away to the winner participants by the hands of Dr Satish Yadav. Miss Manisha Deshpande, Mr. Bhimashankar Wadkar and Mr. Ramraje Kale expressed their views regarding the workshop. The Chief Guest Dr Satish Yadav issued the certificates to the participants and delivered a valedictory speech. The Coordinator of the Workshop Miss M. M. Pandit proposed the vote of thanks. After the Valedictory Function, the participants watched music performance of great singers and interviews of great writers.

On day 3, there was a visit to V Tunes Music Studio, Latur. Mr Nilesh Pathak and Mr Vinayak Rathod had given the information about the studio.
