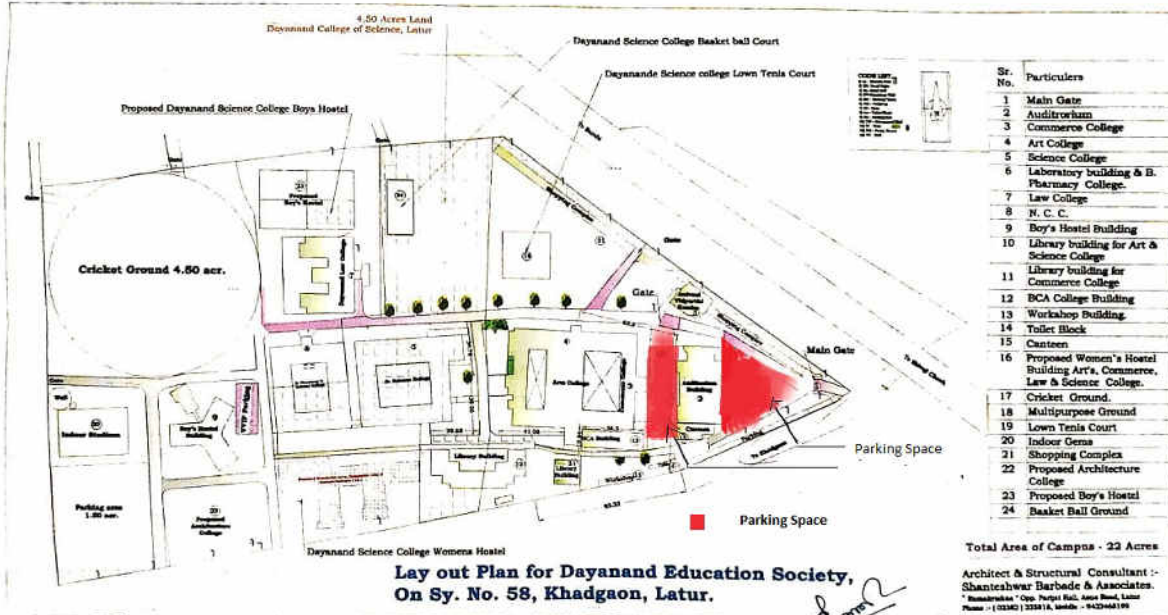

**Bicycle Policy and Regulations
for
Campus Safety and Security.**

Policy Effective: 2nd July, 2017

Purpose:

- This procedure is to establish guidelines for the registration, operation, prohibited activities and fines of bicycles on Dayanand Science College campus

General Guidelines:

- Dayanand Science College recognizes that bicycles are an important and legitimate means of transportation, provided they are operated with due regard and concern for the safety of the general public.
- To provide a safe and efficient means of managing the large number of bicycles on campus, all bicycles operated by Dayanand Science College faculty, staff and students must be registered with the college.
- Dayanand Science College assumes responsibility for the care and protection of any bicycle, attached accessories, or contents inside the college campus.

1. STATEMENT

- The purpose of this procedure is to establish guidelines for the registration, operation, prohibited activities, fines and impoundment of bicycles on Dayanand Science College campus.

2. BICYCLE REGULATIONS

- The bicycle owner is responsible for complying with all bicycle regulations. Persons operating a bicycle on the Dayanand Science College campus are responsible for acquainting themselves with and obeying the bicycle regulations of the College.
- Bicycles that are bearing the registration label, applied as indicated above, are entitled to use the roadways, sidewalks and bicycle racks on campus as specified in these Bicycle Regulations

3. OPERATION

- Pedestrians in crosswalks, on sidewalks, and at all other locations designated for pedestrian traffic shall have the right-of-way over bicycles. Bicycles will NOT be operated within buildings, on the veranda/breezeway/ramp areas of campus.
- Bicycles and cyclists shall in all respects comply with applicable state laws and regulations, including but not limited to turn signals, lighting, brakes, lane changing, etc.
- Cyclists are responsible for controlling the speed of bicycle so as not to endanger any pedestrian.

- Bicycles parked on campus must be parked in a bicycle rack.


4. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- No individual shall park, store, or leave a bicycle in such a manner as to cause said bicycle to block or otherwise obstruct normal entrance to or exit from any building on campus, or in a manner that constitutes a safety hazard. No individual who operates a bicycle on campus shall carry any other individual on the bicycle.
- Bicycles shall not be parked or stored in a walkway, on a sidewalk, in a hallway, on a handicap ramp, or in or near a doorway except where use is made of a parking rack furnished by the college.
- Operating bicycles inside residences or buildings is prohibited. No individual operating a bicycle on campus shall in any way attaches it to a moving vehicle. No individual shall operate any bicycle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

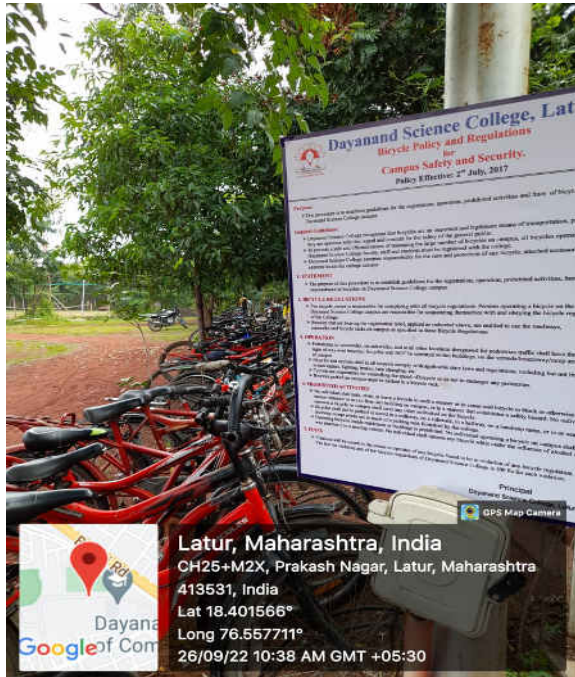
5. FINES

- Citations will be issued to the owner or operator of any bicycle found to be in violation of any bicycle regulation. The fine for violating any of the bicycle regulations of Dayanand Science College is 100 Rs for each violation.

Policy Effective: 10st August, 2018

As per the Ministry of Human Resource Development Guidelines & UGC, for Ban of Plastic Use in Higher Education Institutions.

Introduction


- Plastic pollution is currently one of the biggest environmental concerns.
- According to a report on Plastic Waste Management released by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, the global average of plastic per capita consumption is 28 kg and India has a per capita plastic consumption of 11 kg.
- The Central Pollution Control Board states that 3.5 million metric tonnes of plastic waste are generated in India annually
- The short-term benefits and convenience of plastic and plastic goods have led to a boom in the production and consumption of plastic. Over the past century, excess-consumption of plastic has surpassed management of plastic waste and led it to become a scourge to the planet.
- Plastic is a menace that impacts not the environment as well as our health and wellbeing. We have all contributed to this problem, knowingly and unknowingly and we must work to reduce and eliminate plastic pollution.
- Government has decided to take plastic ban as a national level campaign to address the environmental hazards being caused by the indiscriminate use of plastic.

Guidelines

- Dayanand Science College intends to help to achieve plastic free campus. It is not meant to be exhaustive but to provide directions and tips which shall be applicable to all the stakeholders of the Instruction in general.
- The guidelines encourage adopting policies and practices towards cleaner and plastic free campuses.

- Dayanand Science College is adopting to carry out awareness drives and sensitizing workshops on the harmful impacts of single use plastics.
- Our institution will always ensure plastic-free campus.
- Students to avoid bringing non-bio-degradable plastic items to the institution.
- Institute encourage students to sensitize their respective households about harmful effects of plastics and make their households 'plastic free'
- Students and faculty must work towards this in mission mode.
- Usage of plastics should be stopped in canteens, shopping complexes in the institution's premises and hostels, etc. Students may not be permitted to bring non-bio-degradable plastic items to the institution.
- Every student will strive to make his/her household plastic free.
- Students to be incentivized to carry out similar campaigns at community level.
- Dayanand Science College has all necessary alternative facilities like water units to avoid the purchase and use of plastic water bottles.
- Students must use of alternative solutions like cloth bags etc., to plastic bottles, covers and other goods on campuses.
- Dayanand Science College will conduct events and poster competitions etc. on designing ecological and environment friendly goods to minimize the use of single use plastic.

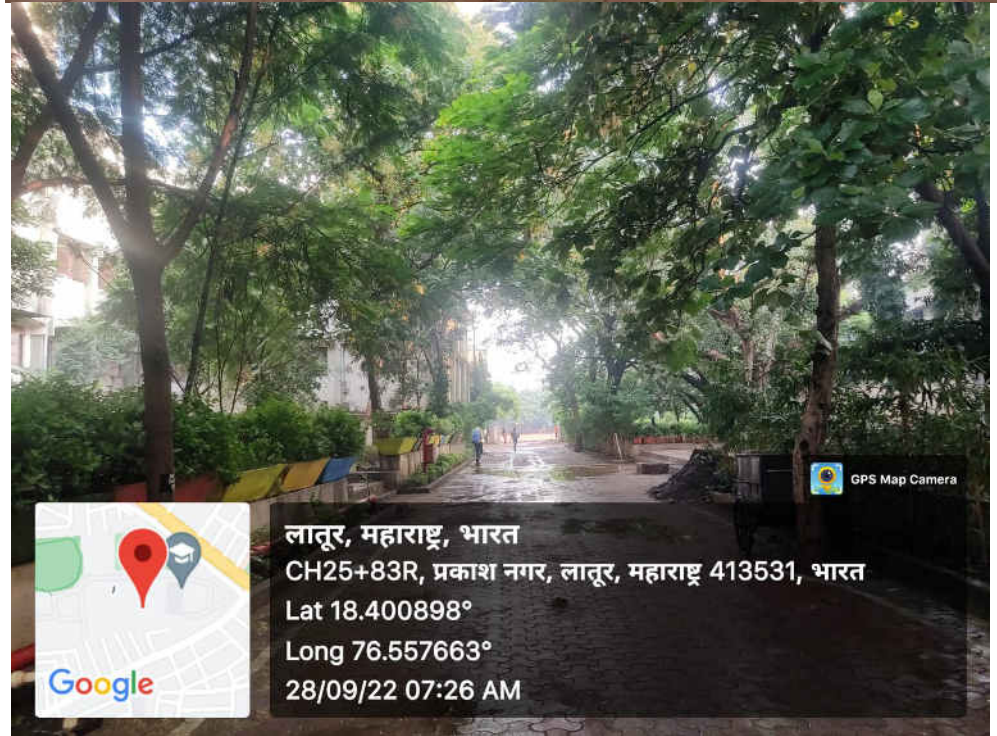
5. Landscaping with trees and plants

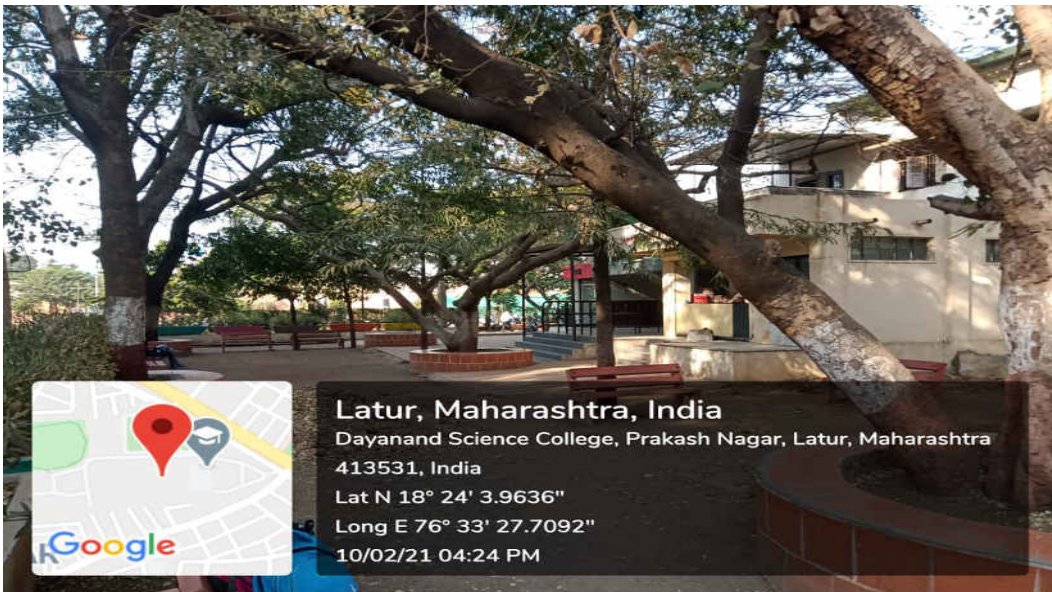
The major part of the campus is covered with greenery and the available area of landscaping of the college premises are also used for plantation. Some of the geotagged photos are shown below:

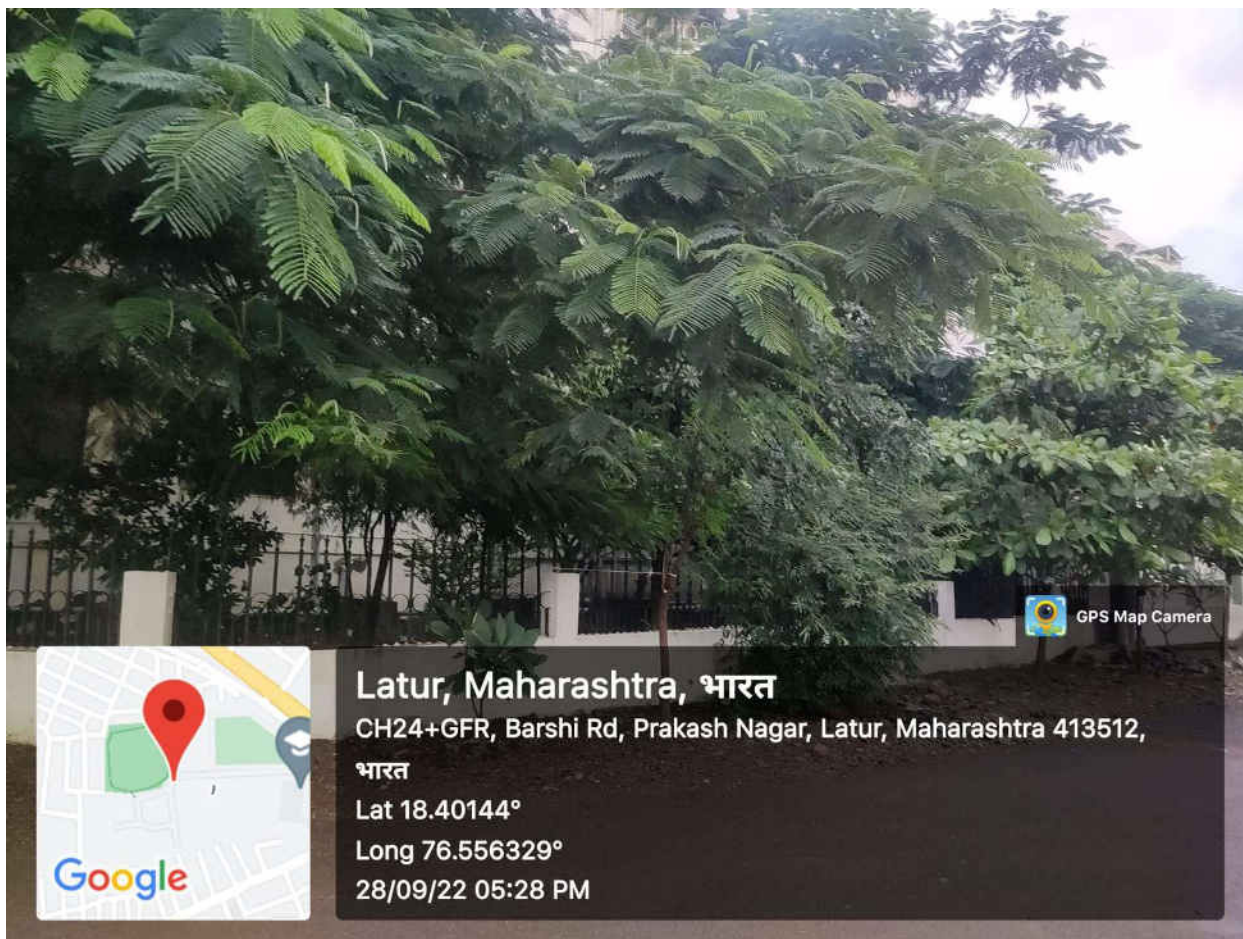
