2. Best Practice-2

Financial assistance to meritorious students through Dayanand Education society and Dayanand Science College

(a) University merit rankers- Felicitation of meritorious students (Gunvatta Sanman Yojana) is one of the best practices adopted by the college. These students are awarded as per their subject wise merit with the cash prizes from deposit money (interest generated from the money deposited by the Trustee, Alumni, faculty members and parents' donors). List of merit students is displayed & the prizes are distributed in gathering and all donors are invited and true copies of the certificates (certificate Xerox) of merit students are also given to donors.

(b) NSS/NCC/Sports/Cultural activities- Many students participate in various University, State, National level games and achieve success. These students need sports materials like Badminton

rackets, cricket bat, sports shoes, balls, ropes, track suits etc. The College promotes these students by giving them incentives in the form of materials so that they can mark their achievement in specific sport competitions.

(c) For creative writings in *Unmesh*- The College publishes annual magazine Unmesh. The College encourages the students to contribute their writings in the form of poetry, essay, social issue, or any other issue they wish to write in any one of the languages (Hindi, Marathi and English).
