Dayanand Science College has once again achieved outstanding success in the MHT-CET 2026 Phase-II examination, with students securing excellent percentile scores in both the PCM and PCB groups. In the PCM group, Kapil Shivaji Mamnagar secured the first rank in the college with 99.79 percentile. Ankita Anant Pawar stood second with 99.70 percentile, while Deepak Prabhakar Dhotre secured the third rank with 99.54 percentile. In the PCB group, Avdhoot Joshi secured the first rank with 99.63 percentile. Shreya Dukare stood second with 99.30 percentile, while Samiksha Bijale secured the third rank with 99.06 percentile. Continuing its tradition of academic excellence, the college recorded an impressive overall performance. A total of 9 students scored above 99 percentile, 15 students scored above 98 percentile, 39 students scored above 95 percentile, and 81 students secured above 90 percentiles.

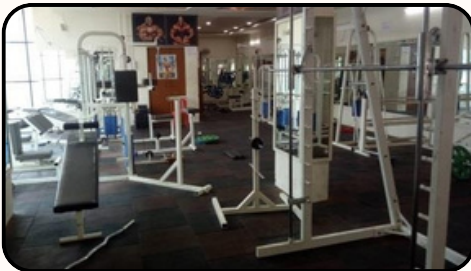
