6.Outstanding Success of Dayanand Science College in MHT-CET (PCM & PCB) 2026 Examination :132 Students Score Above 90 Percentile

Continuing its tradition of academic excellence, Dayanand Science College, Latur has achieved outstanding results in the MHT-CET 2026 examination. In the PCM group, Ankita Pawar secured the first rank in the college with 99.65 percentile. Kapil Mamnagar stood second with 99.62 percentile. Aryan Gaikwad secured the third rank with 99.30 percentile. Deepak Dhotre also performed exceptionally well by scoring 99.05 percentile. 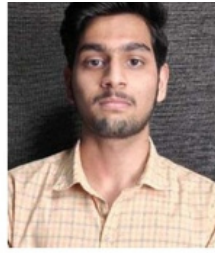

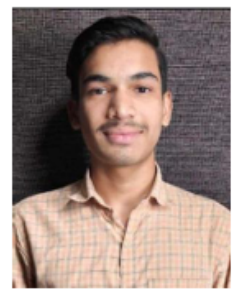

8.High Court Orders Inclusion of Dayanand College in Class XI Admission Portal



The Aurangabad Bench of the Bombay High Court granted relief to Dayanand Science College, Latur, and other reputed junior colleges that were left out of the first round of the Class XI online admission process due to a technical error in the Education Department's admission portal. The online admission process for the academic year 2026–27 began on May 21, 2026. However, the names of Dayanand Science College, Latur, was missing from the admission portal.

This created confusion among students, parents and college authorities. As the issue remained unresolved despite repeated representations to the Education Department, the affected colleges approached the Bombay High Court. On May 25, 2026, the vacation bench of Justice S. G. Chapalgaonkar directed the State Government to immediately include the omitted colleges on the admission portal.

The Court also ordered the Government to extend the deadline for students to submit or revise their college preferences so that no student would lose the opportunity for admission. During the hearing, the Education Department informed the Court that the omission had occurred due to a technical error and confirmed that the names of the affected colleges had been added to the admission portal. The Court's decision brought relief to students and parents.

9.Huge Rush of Students and Parents at Dayanand Science College for First Round of Class XI Admissions



The first round of admissions under the Maharashtra Government's online admission process commenced on 29 May 2026 and 3 June 2026 is the last date for admission in this round. Dayanand Science College has witnessed an overwhelming response from students and parents with a large number of students securing admission based on merit. Many students and parents have also approached the college seeking guidance regarding the selection of preference order and other admission-related information to improve their chances of securing admission in the second round. Students who have not yet completed their online admission registration have also contacted the college for assistance in obtaining admission during the second round. The college has planned to commence regular classes immediately for all students whose admissions have been confirmed, and students have been informed accordingly. Parents and students are keen to secure admission to Dayanand Science College through the second merit list as well. The primary reason for this demand is that the college is one of the most reputed institutions in Maharashtra and is recognized for producing outstanding results in JEE, CET and NEET examinations.
